**TO: ALL HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS Graduating in June 2011.**

1. The Most Valuable Student Scholarship applications will be available on line after September 1, 2010 with the Deadline back to the lodge on or before December 1, 2010.

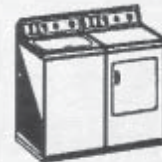
